

RESOLUTION

TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF RAVENSWOOD, WEST VIRGINIA, TO ESTABLISH A MUNICIPAL BUILDING COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Chapter 8, Article 33 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended (“the Act”), authorizes any municipality to create and establish a municipal building commission, having the powers and authority contained in the Act; and

WHEREAS, the City Code of Ordinances §33.81 requires that the Building Commission consist of three (3) persons to serve five (5) year terms, with the initial terms to be staggered at three (3), four (4), and five (5) years; with no more than two members appointed from the same political party; with no member holding any office or employment under the United States of America, the State of West Virginia or any county or political subdivision thereof or any political party; and each member shall be a resident of the City of Ravenswood; and


WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Ravenswood has determined and does hereby determine that it is necessary and desirable that municipal building commission to be known as “Ravenswood Building Commission” be created and established; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City of Ravenswood, hereby resolves to form, crate, and establish a municipal building commission to be known as “Ravenswood Building Commission,” (the “Building Commission”) which shall have all of the powers granted by the Act and any other powers granted to it by applicable law. The following persons shall be appointed to the Building Commission:

<u>Member</u>	<u>Term Expiration</u>
Jeremy Dlugos (3 year term)	August 4, 2023
Charles Shaver (4 year term)	August 4, 2024
Stephen W. Cogar (5 year term)	August 4, 2025

The foregoing Resolution was introduced and read at the regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Ravenswood on August 4, 2020. On that same day, Councilman Fox moved for the adoption of said Resolution and authorization for the Honorable Joshua Miller, Mayor of the City of Ravenswood, to sign said Resolution. The motion was seconded by Councilwoman Scritchfield. After discussion, the Common Council of the City of Ravenswood adopted the foregoing Resolution and authorization with all voting for the Resolution and authorization and none against.
