## RESOLUTION

## Appointing and Confirming Members to the Historic Landmark Commission

WHEREAS, the City of Ravenswood has enacted §2.16.040 et seq. of the Ravenswood Municipal Code, creating the Historic Landmark Commission (hereinafter "Commission"); and

WHEREAS, the Code requires that the Commission shall: (A) Be composed of 5 members appointed by the Mayor of the City to a term commencing on the first day of August in the following manner: (1) One member shall be a member of the Common Council, shall be appointed by said Mayor and shall serve a term of 1 year; (2) Two members shall be appointed by the Mayor from the city at large, their initial appointments being for a period of 2 years and all subsequent appointments being for a period of 1 year; (3) Two members shall be appointed by the Mayor from the city at large, their initial appointments being for a period of 1 year and all subsequent appointments being for a period of 1 year; and

WHEREAS, the Commission presently has vacancies due to the expiration of the terms; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Common Council of the City of Ravenswood, hereby appoints and confirms the following Mayoral nominations to the Historic Landmarks Commission, as follows:
